BANK DEBITS AND DEPOSIT TURNOVER

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts, except interbank and U. S. Government accounts, as reported by banks in 344 selected centers for the month of October aggregated \$337.1 billion. During the past three months debits amounted to \$947.6 billion or 11.3 per cent above the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago.

At banks in New York City there was an increase of 11.1 per cent compared with the corresponding three-months period a year ago; at 6 other leading centers the increase was 13.1 per cent; and at 337 other centers it was 10.4 per cent.

Seasonally adjusted debits to demand deposit accounts for 344 centers declined in October from the September high. Debits at banks in New York City, totaling \$133.7 billion in October, were 4.6 per cent below their previous high in September while those at banks in 6 leading centers and 337 other centers, which totaled \$69.4 and \$123.6 billion respectively, were slightly higher than the revised September levels. The seasonally adjusted annual rate of turnover at banks outside New York City increased further in October to 34.9, while at New York City banks, turnover declined 10.0 per cent to a seasonally adjusted level of 87.2.
