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## BANK DEBITS AND DEPOSIT TURNOVER

For immediate release  
May 19, 1965

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts except interbank and U. S. Government accounts for the month of April, of banks in 225 Standard Metropolitan Statistical Areas and other centers, were \$5,113.3 billion at a seasonally adjusted annual rate. This is 2.4 per cent higher than the previous month and 11.1 per cent higher than April 1964.

New York area banks reported an increase of 3.8 per cent from March 1965 and an increase of 12.7 per cent from April a year ago. The 6 Other Centers classification reported a 1.5 per cent increase from March and 9.0 per cent increase from April of last year. The 224 and 218 Centers classifications reported 1.3 and 1.2 per cent increases, respectively, when compared to last month and 10.0 and 10.6 per cent increases from the same month a year ago.

The April turnover of demand deposits rate for New York continued a five month increase reaching the 100 level for the first time in the revised series. The turnover rate remained the same at 218 centers but declined slightly at the 6 Other Centers and All Centers (excluding New York) classifications. Finally, the New York increase resulted in the rate for All Centers increasing for the eighth straight month to a level of 48.4.
