BANK DEBITS AND DEPOSIT TURNOVER

For immediate release
July 16, 1965

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts, except interbank and U. S. Government accounts, for the month of June from banks in 225 Standard Metropolitan Statistical Areas and other centers, were \$5,336.1 billion at a seasonally adjusted annual rate. This is 10.6 per cent higher than the previous month and 17.7 per cent higher than June 1964.

New York area banks reported an increase of 18.1 per cent from May 1965 and an increase of 19.7 per cent from June a year ago. The 6 Other Centers classification reported an increase of 5.9 per cent from May and a 15.6 per cent increase from June of last year. The 224 and 218 Centers classifications reported 5.4 and 5.2 per cent increases, respectively, when compared to last month; and 16.1 and 16.5 per cent increases from the same month a year ago.

In June the turnover of demand deposit rates for the five national classifications reversed the declines posted last month. In each of these five classifications turnover rates reached new highs, rising to 36.3 at All Centers (excluding New York) and 51.0 for 225 Centers. The sharpest increase was at banks in New York where the turnover rate rose to 107.
