BANK DEBITS AND DEPOSIT TURNOVER

For immediate release
August 17, 1965

Bank debits to demand deposits accounts except interbank and U. S. Government accounts for the month of July, of banks in 225 Standard Metropolitan Statistical Areas and other centers, were \$5,302.6 billion at a seasonally adjusted annual rate. This is about one-half of 1 per cent lower than the previous month and 9.7 per cent higher than July 1964.

New York area banks reported a decrease of 1.2 per cent from June 1965 and an increase of 9.3 per cent from July a year ago. The 6 Other Centers classification reported a slight increase from June and a 8.6 per cent increase from July of last year. The 224 and 218 Centers classifications each showed little change from the previous month but posted 10 per cent and 10.9 per cent increases, respectively, from the same month a year ago.

The turnover of demand deposits declined in July for each of the five major classifications although the July rate for each category continued to be above the corresponding average rate for the first six months of the year.
