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BANK DEBITS AND DEPOSIT TURNOVER

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts (except interbank and U. S. Government accounts) for the month of September, of banks in 225 Standard Metropolitan Statistical Areas and other centers, were \$5,126.9 billion at a seasonally adjusted annual rate. There was a slight decrease from the previous month and a 7.6 per cent increase from September of last year.

Reported bank debits at New York area banks declined 1.1 per cent from August 1965 but showed an increase of 4.8 per cent from September a year ago. The other three national classifications remained at about the same levels as in August. However, compared to a year ago they showed increases of 8.9 per cent at the 6 leading Centers and 9.7 and 10.2 increases, respectively, at 224 and 218 Centers.

The rate of turnover of demand deposits declined in each of the five national classifications during September. Turnover rates at New York and 6 Other Centers dropped to the lowest levels since January of this year. Declines at 224 and 218 Centers were not as pronounced as those posted at the two Leading Centers groupings.
