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BANK DEBITS
AND DEPOSIT TURNOVERFor immediate release
November 17, 1965

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts (except interbank and U. S. Government accounts) for the month of October, of banks in 225 Standard Metropolitan Statistical Areas and other centers, were \$5,129.9 billion at a seasonally adjusted annual rate. There was a slight increase from the previous month and a 9.2 per cent increase over October of last year.

Bank debits at New York area banks declined 2.1 per cent from September 1965 but showed an increase of 7.0 per cent over October a year ago. The other three national summary classifications reported moderate monthly increases in October. Compared to a year ago, debits at the 6 leading Centers were up 9.9 per cent and at 218 Other Centers were up 11.3 per cent.

Rates of turnover of demand deposits changed only slightly in October, with a small increase in turnover at New York banks offsetting a small decline at the 6 Other leading Centers. Turnover continued at the September rate at 218 Other Centers.
