BANK DEBITS AND DEPOSIT TURNOVER

For immediate release
July 20, 1966

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts (except interbank and U. S. Government accounts) for the month of June of banks in 225 Standard Metropolitan Statistical Areas and other centers, were \$5,868.8 billion at a seasonally adjusted annual rate. This is 1.2 per cent higher than the previous month and 10.2 per cent higher than June 1965.

New York area banks reported an increase of 1.7 per cent from the preceding month and an increase of 7.9 per cent over June a year ago. Month ago comparisons showed a slight increase in the 6 Other Centers; and increases of .9 per cent and 1.3 per cent at the 224 Centers and 218 Centers. When compared to a year ago these three classifications showed percentage increases of 14.6, 11.8, and 10.1, respectively.

In June, the rate of demand deposit turnover increased slightly to a new high at banks in the 225 reporting centers. The seasonally adjusted annual rate of turnover at these banks is estimated at 53.7. Turnover increased at banks in each of the major classifications, except in New York.
