BANK DEBITS AND DEPOSIT TURNOVER

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts (except interbank and U. S. Government accounts) for the month of February of banks in 233 Standard Metropolitan Statistical Areas and other centers were \$6,294.9 billion at a seasonally adjusted annual rate. This was slightly lower than the previous month but 11.0 per cent higher than February 1966.

New York area banks reported a decrease of 4.3 per cent from the preceding month and an increase of 14.7 per cent over February a year ago. Compared to a year ago, debits at 6 Other Centers were up 9.9 per cent and at 226 Centers debits were up 8.3 per cent.

Demand deposit turnover decreased slightly in 233 reporting centers to a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 55.6. Turnover at banks in New York and in 226 Other Centers declined from the record rates reported for January, while the rate for 6 Other Leading Centers increased slightly.
