BANK DEBITS AND DEPOSIT TURNOVER

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts (except interbank and U.S. Government accounts) for the month of March of banks in 233 Standard Metropolitan Statistical Areas and other centers were \$6,315.9 billion at a seasonally adjusted annual rate. This was slightly higher than the previous month and 9.2 per cent higher than March 1966.

New York area banks reported an increased of 1.2 per cent from the preceding month and an increase of 14.3 per cent over March a year ago. Compared to a year ago, debits at 6 Other Centers were up 5.6 per cent and at 226 Centers debits were up 5.5 per cent.

Demand deposit turnover decreased in the 233 reporting centers to a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 54.8. The largest decline was at the banks in New York, but the rate for 232 Other Leading Centers also declined slightly to the lowest level since August 1966.
