BANK DEBITS AND DEPOSIT TURNOVER

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts (except interbank and U. S. Government accounts) for the month of October for banks in 233 Standard Metropolitan Statistical areas and other centers were \$6,993.0 billion at a seasonally adjusted annual rate. This was 2.8 per cent higher than the previous month and 15.3 per cent higher than October 1966.

New York area banks reported an increase of 5.1 per cent from the preceding month and an increase of 21.6 per cent over October a year ago. Compared to a year ago, debits at 6 Other Centers were up 12.7 per cent, and at 226 Centers the increase was 9.5 per cent.

Demand deposit turnover on an aggregate basis for 233 reporting centers increased to 58.3 in October. The rate of turnover continued to fluctuate in New York, increasing sharply in October, while the rate declined slightly in 6 Other Centers and it remained unchanged from September in 226 Centers.
