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BANK DEBITS AND DEPOSIT TURNOVER

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts (except interbank and U. S. Government accounts) for the month of December for banks in 233 Standard Metropolitan Statistical areas and other centers were \$7,047.0 billion at a seasonally adjusted annual rate. This was 0.1 per cent higher than the previous month and 10.0 per cent higher than December 1966.

New York area banks reported an increase of 1.6 per cent from the preceding month and an increase of 10.7 per cent over December a year ago. Compared to a year ago, debits at 6 Other Centers were up 7.9 per cent, and at 226 Centers the increase was 10.4 per cent.

Demand deposit turnover at banks in 233 reporting centers continued to show little change on balances in December, although the rate of turnover in New York dropped sharply and the rate also decreased slightly in 6 Other Centers. These decreases in turnover in December were offset by an increase to a new high at banks in the 226 Other Centers.
