



## BANK DEBITS AND DEPOSIT TURNOVER

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts (except interbank and U. S. Government accounts) for the month of May for banks in 233 Standard Metropolitan Statistical areas and other centers were \$7,948.5 billion at a seasonally adjusted annual rate. This was 4.4 per cent higher than the previous month and 19.8 per cent higher than June 1967.

New York area banks reported an increase of 6.7 per cent from the preceding month and an increase of 23.8 per cent over June a year ago. Compared to a year ago, debits at 6 Other Centers were up 20.0 per cent, and at 226 Centers the increase was 14.4 per cent.

Demand deposit turnover continued to advance to new highs during the month of June. The greatest increase in turnover was reported by banks in the New York area where the annual rate surpassed the previous high of last November. All other major classifications of reporting centers also increased to new highs.
