## BANK DEBITS AND DEPOSIT TURNOVER

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts (except interbank and U. S. Government accounts) for the month of November for banks in 233 Standard Metropolitan Statistical areas and other centers were \$8,540.1 billion at the seasonally adjusted annual rate. This was 0.7 per cent lower than the previous month and 22.0 per cent higher than November 1967.

New York area banks reported a decrease of 0.7 per cent from the preceding month and an increase of 26.6 per cent over November a year ago. Compared to a year ago, debits at 6 Other Centers were up 22.2 per cent, and at 226 Centers the increase was 15.9 per cent.

Demand deposit turnover for 233 Centers increased slightly further to a new high in November due to an increase in the rate of turnover at banks in the New York area. Banks in other centers reported slight reductions in turnover rates.
