Bank debits to demand deposit accounts (except interbank and U. S. Government accounts) for the month of April for banks in 233 Standard Metropolitan Statistical areas and other centers were \$8,883.9 billion at the seasonally adjusted annual rate. This was 1.8 per cent higher than the previous month and 18.4 per cent higher than April 1968.

New York area banks reported an increase of .5 per cent from the preceding month and an increase 18.8 per cent over April a year ago. Compared to a year ago, debits at 6 Other Centers were up 21.2 per cent, and at 226 Centers the increase was 16.2 per cent.

Demand deposit turnover for 233 Centers was little changed during April, as a reduction in turnover at New York area banks was offset by increases at banks in other centers.
