AND DEPOSIT TURNOVER

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts (except interbank and U. S. Government accounts) for the month of May for banks in 233 Standard Metropolitan Statistical areas and other centers were \$9,147.6 billion at the seasonally adjusted annual rate. This was 3.0 per cent higher than the previous month and 20.1 per cent higher than May 1968.

New York area banks reported an increase of 5.0 per cent from the preceding month and an increase of 21.6 per cent over May a year ago. Compared to a year ago, debits at 6 Other Centers were up 21.0 per cent, and at 226 Centers the increase was 17.7 per cent.

Demand deposit turnover advanced to a new high during the month of May. The greatest increase was reported by banks in the New York area. All other major classifications of reporting centers also showed increases.
