AND DEPOSIT TURNOVER

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts (except interbank and U. S. Government accounts) for the month of August for banks in 233 Standard Metropolitan Statistical areas and other centers were \$9,430.3 billion at the seasonally adjusted annual rate. This was 2.0 per cent higher than the previous month and 10.7 per cent higher than August 1968.

New York area banks reported an increase of 6.1 per cent from the preceding month and an increase of 1.7 per cent over August a year ago. Compared to a year ago, debits at 6 Other Centers were up 22.9 per cent, and at 226 Centers the increase was 16.1 per cent.

Demand deposit turnover reached a new high during the month of August. Turnover rates increased generally in all major classifications, rising to new highs in all areas except New York.
