The monthly seasonally adjusted annual rates for bank debits and the seasonally adjusted month-end deposit data for the 233 centers reporting in the bank debits, deposits and deposit turnover series, has been revised. As a result, the seasonally adjusted data for January 1972, are being reported on a revised basis beginning with this release. This revision incorporates the following changes:

- (1) Trading day adjustments have been recalculated and applied to all debits data and seasonal adjustments have been recalculated and applied to both debits and deposits data for all centers in the Board's national series.
- (2) Coverage of Standard Metropolitan Statistical Areas now in the national series have been extended to reflect redefinition of their geographic boundaries as defined by the Office of Management and Budget.
- (3) Transfer of Sedalia, Missouri from the St. Louis Federal Reserve District to the Kansas City District. The expansion of boundary coverage affects only five SMSA's in the national series.

The combination of two existing SMSA's, Greensboro-High Point, North Carolina and Winston-Salem, North Carolina, now designated as a single SMSA, have been combined to conform with existing boundaries. However, since the coverage for the existing SMSA remains the same as previously reported, the number of reporting centers in the national series has not been reduced.

Revised data for the national series from 1964 to date will be made available in a forthcoming Bulletin.
