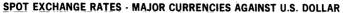

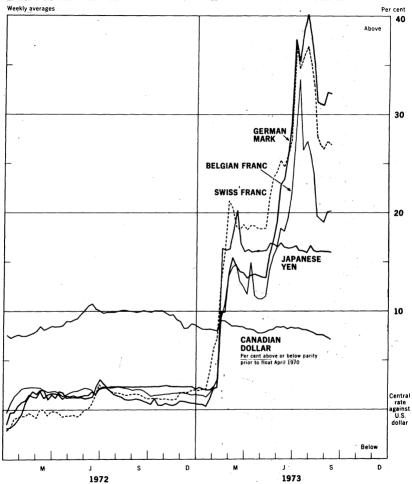

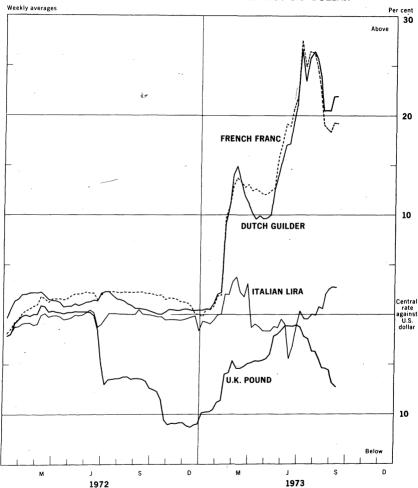

Weekly averages (week ending on Friday) of daily offered rates in the New York market as per cent above or below Smithsonian central rates.

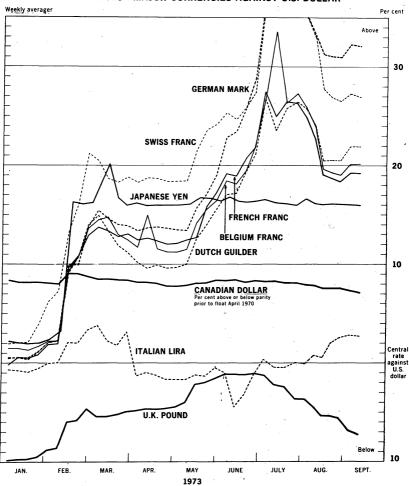
SPOT EXCHANGE RATES - MAJOR CURRENCIES AGAINST U.S. DOLLAR

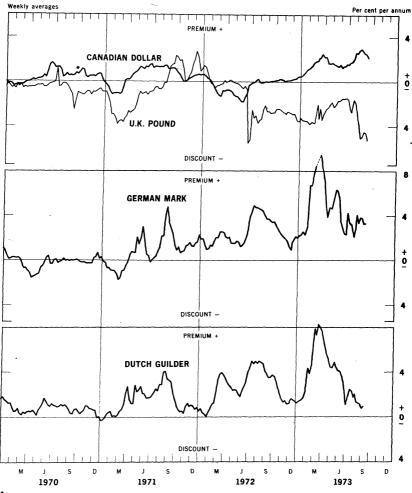

SPOT EXCHANGE RATES - MAJOR CURRENCIES AGAINST U.S. DOLLAR



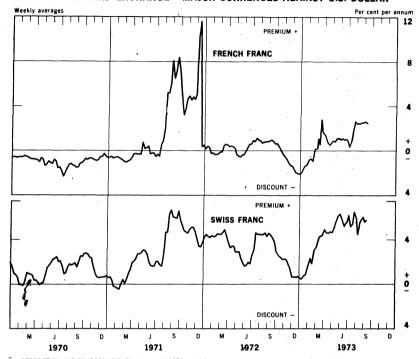

3-MONTH FORWARD EXCHANGE - MAJOR CURRENCES AGAINST U.S. DOLLAR



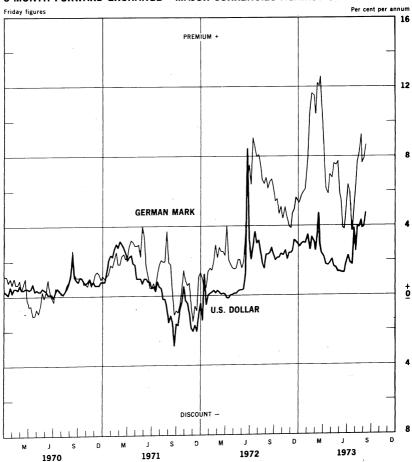

3-MONTH FORWARD EXCHANGE - MAJOR CURRENCES AGAINST U.S. DOLLAR



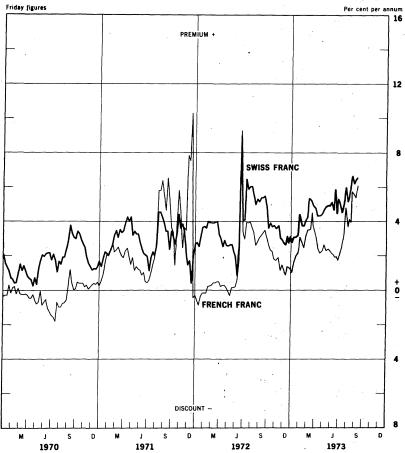

3-MONTH FORWARD EXCHANGE - MAJOR CURRENCIES AGAINST U.K. POUND



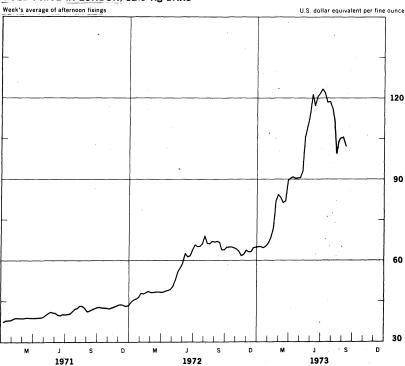

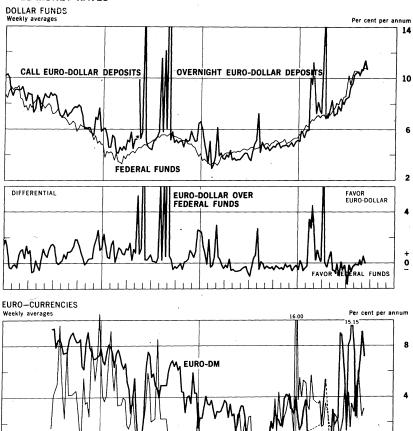

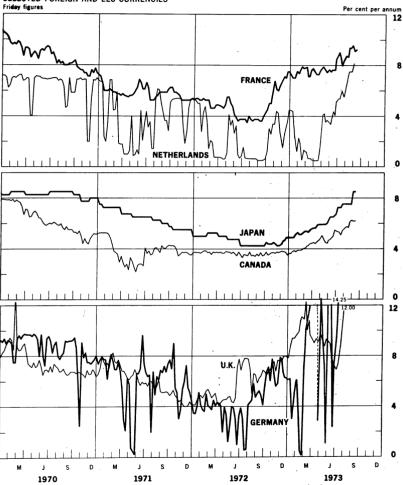

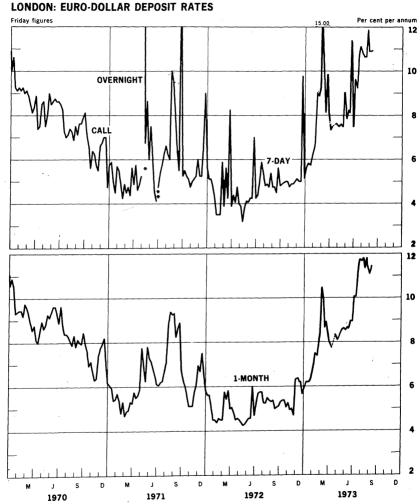

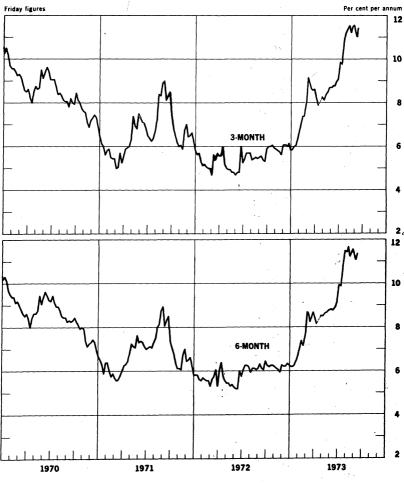

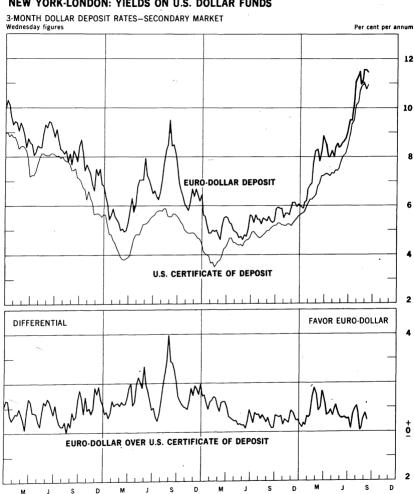

NEW YORK-LONDON: YIELDS ON U.S. DOLLAR FUNDS



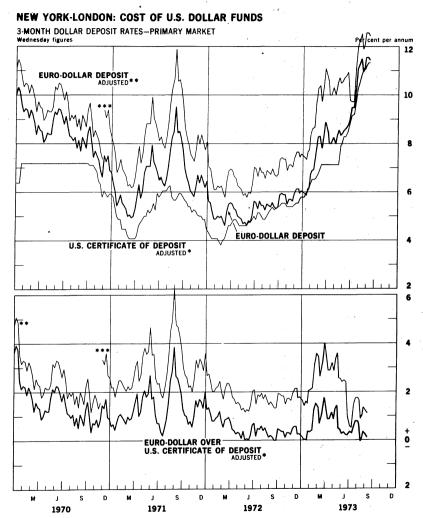

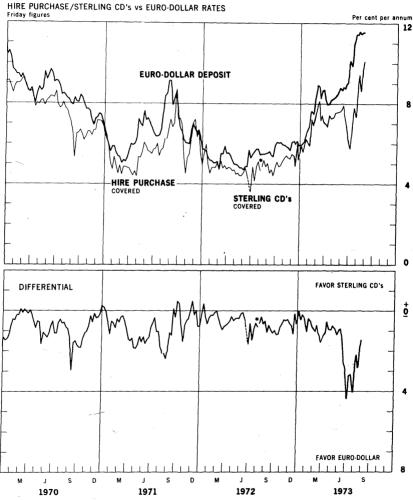

LONDON: COVERED YIELDS ON U.S. DOLLAR FUNDS

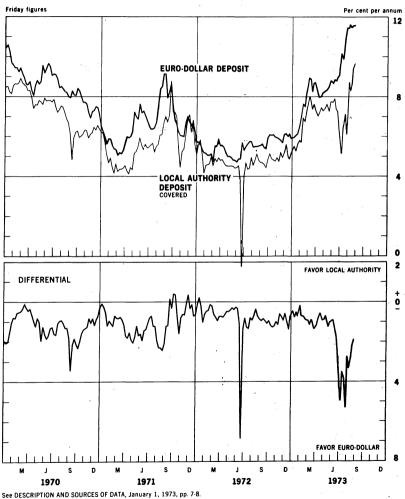

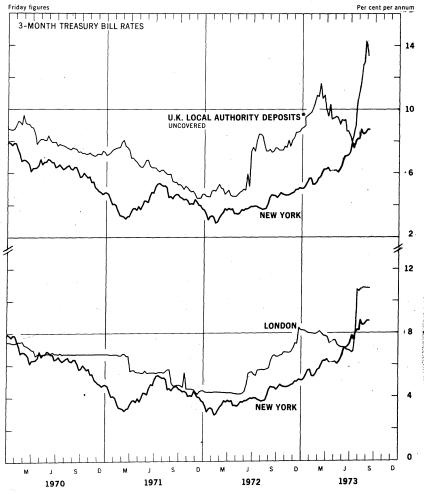
LONDON: COVERED YIELDS ON U.S. DOLLAR FUNDS

LOCAL AUTHORITY AND EURO-DOLLAR RATES



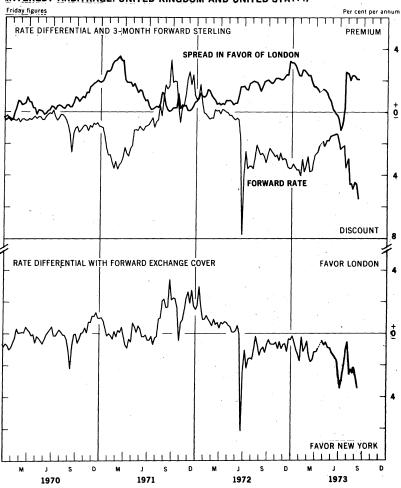

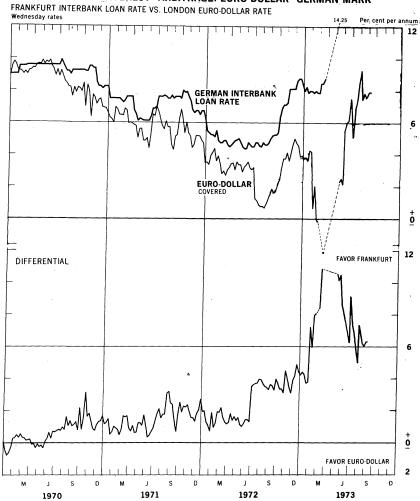

3-MONTH FUNDS INTEREST ARBITRAGE: EURO-DOLLAR-GERMAN MARK

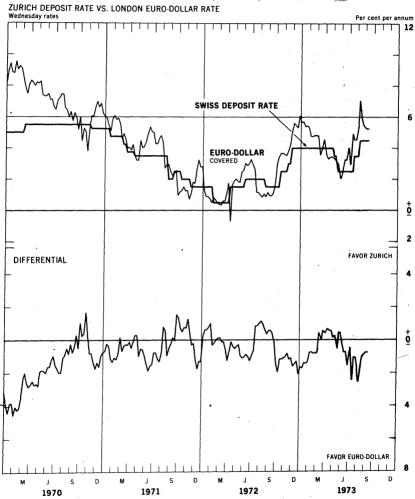

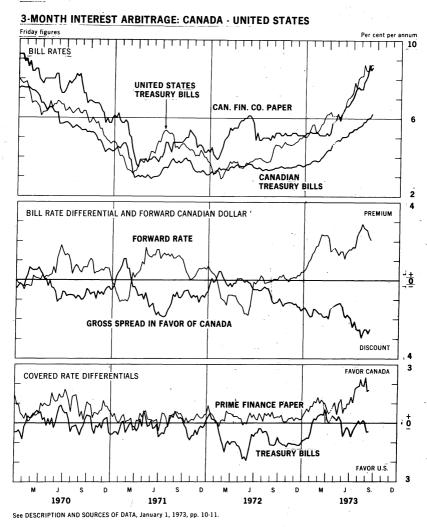


3-MONTH FUNDS INTEREST ARBITRAGE: EURO-DOLLAR - SWISS FRANC



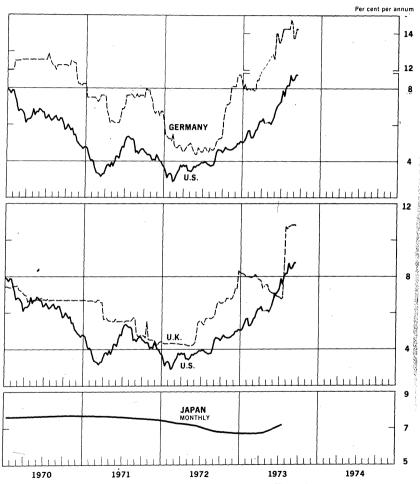

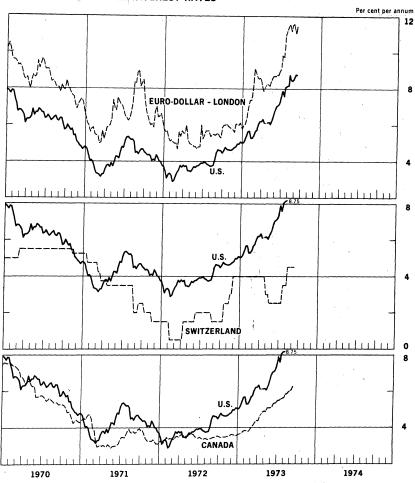
SELECTED SHORT-TERM INTEREST RATES*

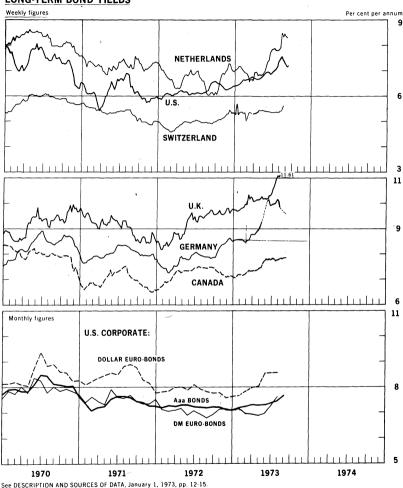

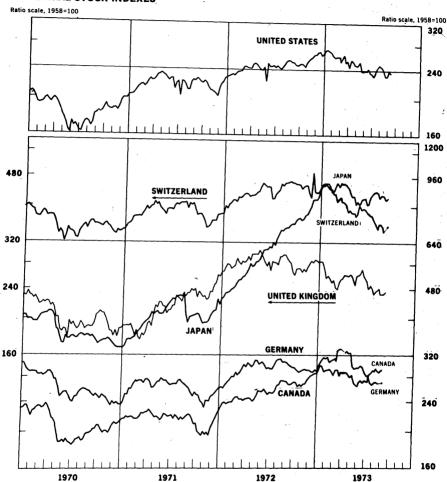
