- 1/ MEMBER BANK RESERVES SERIES REFLECT ACTUAL RESERVE REQUIREMENT PERCENTAGES WITH NO ADJUSTMENT TO ELIMINATE THE EFFECT OF CHANGES IN REGULATIONS D AND H. EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 11, 1979, AN 8 PERCENTAGE POINT MARGINAL RESERVE REQUIREMENT WAS IMPOSED ON "MANAGED LIABILITIES". ON OCTOBER 25, 1979, RESERVES OF EDGE ACT CORPORATIONS WERE INCLUDED IN MEMBER BANK RESERVES. THIS ACTION RAISED REQUIRED RESERVES \$318 MILLION. EFFECTIVE MARCH 12, 1980, THE 8 PERCENTAGE POINT MARGINAL RESERVE REQUIREMENT WAS RAISED TO 10 PERCENTAGE POINTS. IN ADDITION THE BASE UPON WHICH THE MARGINAL RESERVE REQUIREMENT IS CALCULATED WAS REDUCED. THIS ACTION INCREASED REQUIRED RESERVES ABOUT \$1,693 MILLION IN THE WEEK ENDING APRIL 2, 1980. EFFECTIVE MAY 29, 1980, THE MARGINAL RESERVE REQUIREMENT WAS REDUCED FROM 10 TO 5 PERCENTAGE POINTS AND THE BASE UPON WHICH THE MARGINAL RESERVE REQUIREMENT IS CALCULATED WAS RAISED. THIS ACTION REDUCED REQUIRED RESERVES ABOUT \$980 MILLION IN THE WEEK ENDING JUNE 18, 1980.
- 2/ INCLUDES TOTAL RESERVES (MEMBER BANK RESERVE BALANCES IN THE CURRENT WEEK PLUS VAULT CASH HELD TWO WEEKS EARLIER); CURRENCY OUTSIDE THE U.S. TREASURY, FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS AND THE VAULTS OF COMMERCIAL BANKS; AND VAULT CASH OF NONMEMBER BANKS.
- 3/ RESERVE AGGREGATES SERIES HAVE BEEN ADJUSTED TO REMOVE DISCONTINUITIES ASSOCIATED WITH MARGINAL RESERVE REQUIREMENTS, THE INCLUSIONS OF EDGE ACT CORPORATION RESERVES, AND OTHER CHANGES IN REGULATIONS D, K, AND M.
