DISCONTINUITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MONETARY CONTROL ACT, THE INCLUSION OF EDGE ACT CORPORATION RESERVES, AND OTHER CHANGES IN REGULATION D HAVE BEEN REMOVED. BEGINNING WITH THE WEEK ENDED DECEMBER 23, 1981, RESERVES AGGREGATES HAVE BEEN REDUCED BY SHIFTS OF RESERVABLE LIABILITIES TO INTERNATIONAL BANKING FACILITIES (IBFS). ON THE BASIS OF REPORTS OF LIABILITIES TRANSFERRED TO IBFS BY U.S. COMMERCIAL BANKS AND U.S. AGENCIES AND BRANCHES OF FOREIGN BANKS, IT IS ESTIMATED THAT REQUIRED RESERVES WERE LOWERED ON AVERAGE BY \$10 TO \$20 MILLION IN DECEMBER 1981 AND \$40 TO \$70 MILLION IN JANUARY 1982.
- RESERVE BALANCES WITH FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS (WHICH EXCLUDE REQUIRED CLEARING BALANCES) PLUS VAULT CASH AT INSTITUTIONS WITH REQUIRED RESERVE BALANCES PLUS VAULT CASH EQUAL TO REQUIRED RESERVES AT OTHER INSTITUTIONS.

INCLUDES REQUIRED RESERVES OF MEMBER BANKS AND EDGE ACT CORPORATIONS AND, BEGINNING NOVEMBER 13, 1980, OTHER DEPOSITORY INSTITUTIONS. UNDER THE TRANSITIONAL PHASE-IN PROGRAM OF THE MONETARY CONTROL ACT OF 1980 AND PROVISIONS OF THE DEPOSITORY INSTITUTIONS ACT OF 1982, THE NET CHANGES IN REQUIRED RESERVES OF DEPOSITORY INSTITUTIONS HAVE BEEN AS FOLLOWS: EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 13, 1980, A REDUCTION OF \$2.9 BILLION; FEBRUARY 12, 1981, AN INCREASE OF \$245 MILLION; MARCH 12, 1981, AN INCREASE OF \$75 MILLION; MAY 14, 1981, AN INCREASE OF \$245 MILLION; SEPTEMBER 3, 1981, A REDUCTION OF \$1.1 BILLION; NOVEMBER 12, 1981, AN INCREASE OF \$210 MILLION; JANUARY 14, 1982, A REDUCTION OF \$60 MILLION; FEBRUARY 11, 1982 AN INCREASE OF \$170 MILLION; MARCH 4, 1982, AN ESTIMATED REDUCTION OF \$2.0 BILLION; MAY 13, 1982, AN ESTIMATED INCREASE OF \$150 MILLION; AUGUST 12, 1982, AN ESTIMATED INCREASE OF \$140 MILLION; SEPTEMBER 2, 1982, AN ESTIMATED REDUCTION OF \$1.2 BILLION; OCTOBER 28, 1982, AN ESTIMATED REDUCTION \$100 MILLION; DECEMBER 23, 1982, AN ESTIMATED REDUCTION OF \$800 MILLION; AND MARCH 3, 1983, AN ESTIMATED REDUCTION OF \$2.1 BILLION. BEGINNING WITH THE WEEK ENDED DECEMBER 23, 1981, RESERVE AGGREGATES HAVE BEEN REDUCED BY SHIFTS OF RESERVABLE LIABILITIES TO INTERNATIONAL BANKING FACILITIES (IBFS). ON THE BASIS OF REPORTS OF LIABILITIES TRANSFERRED TO IBFS BY U.S. COMMERCIAL BANKS AND AND AGENCIES AND BRANCHES OF FOREIGN BANKS, IT IS ESTIMATED THAT REQUIRED RESERVES WERE LOWERED ON AVERAGE BY \$60 TO \$90 MILLION IN DECEMBER 1981 AND \$180 TO \$230 MILLION IN JANUARY 1982, MOSTLY REFLECTING A REDUCTION IN RESERVABLE EURO CURRENCY TRANSACTIONS.
