- 1/ RESERVES AND MORETARY BASE PIGURES INCORPORATE ADJUSTMENTS POR DISCOUTINUITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MODETARY CONTROL ACT AND OTHER REGULATORY CHANGES TO RESERVE REQUIREMENTS. TO ADJUST POR DISCONTINUITIES DUE TO CHANGES IN RESERVE REQUIREMENTS ON RESERVABLE MONDEPOSIT LIABILITIES, THE SUM OF SUCH REQUIRED RESERVES ARE SUBTRACTED PROB THE ACTUAL SERIES. SIBILARLY, IN ADJUSTING FOR DISCONTINUITIES IN THE HONETARY BASE, REQUIRED CLEARING BALANCES AND ADJUSTMENTS TO COMPENSATE FOR PLOAT ALSO ARE SUBTRACTED PROB THE ACTUAL SERIES.
