- 1/ RESERVES AND HOWETARY BASE FIGURES INCORPORATE ADJUSTMENTS FOR DISCONTINUITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MONETARY CONTROL ACT AND OTHER REGULATORY CHANGES TO RESERVE REQUIREMENTS. TO ADJUST FOR DISCONTINUITIES DUE TO CHANGES IN RESERVE REQUIREMENTS ON RESERVABLE NONDEPOSIT LIABILITIES, THE SUM OF SUCH REQUIRED RESERVES ARE SUBTRACTED PROM THE ACTUAL SERIES. SIMILARLY, IN ADJUSTING FOR DISCONTINUITIES IN THE MONETARY BASE, REQUIRED CLEARING BALANCES AND ADJUSTMENTS TO COMPENSATE FOR FLOAT ALSO ARE SUBTRACTED FROM THE ACTUAL SERIES.
- 2/ TOTAL RESERVES NOT ADJUSTED FOR DISCONTINUITIES CONSISTS OF RESERVE BALANCES WITH PEDERAL RESERVE BANKS (WHICH EXCLUDE REQUIRED CLEARING BALANCES AND ADJUSTMENTS TO COMPENSATE FOR PLOAT) PLUS VAULT CASH USED TO SATISFY RESERVE REQUIREMENTS. SUCH VAULT CASH CONSISTS OF ALL VAULT CASH HELD DURING THE LAGGED COMPUTATION PERIOD BY INSTITUTIONS HAVING PEGUIRED RESERVE BALANCES AT FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS PLUS THE AMOUNT OF VAULT CASH EQUAL TO REQUIRED RESERVES DURING THE MAINTENANCE PERIOD AT INSTITUTIONS HAVING NO REQUIRED RESERVE BALANCES.
- EXTENDED CREDIT CONSISTS OF BORROWING AT THE DISCOUNT WINDOW UNDER THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS ESTABLISHED FOR THE EXTENDED CREDIT PROGRAM TO HELP DEPOSITORY INSTITUTIONS DEAL WITH SUSTAINED LIQUIDITY PRESSURES. BECAUSE THERE IS NOT THE SAME WEED TO REPAY SUCH BORROWING PROMPTLY AS THERE IS WITH TRADITIONAL SHORT-TERM ADJUSTMENT CREDIT, THE MONRY MARKET IMPACT OF EXTENDED CREDIT IS SIMILAR TO THAT OF NONBORROWED RESERVES.
- 4/ RESERVE BALANCES WITH FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS PLUS VAULT CASH USED TO SATISFY RESERVE REQUIREMENTS LESS REQUIRED RESERVES.
- 5/ THE MONETARY BASE NOT ADJUSTED FOR DISCONTINUITIES CONSISTS OF TOTAL RESERVES PLUS REQUIRED CLEARING BALANCES AND ADJUSTMENTS TO COMPENSATE FOR FLOAT AT FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS PLUS THE CURRENCY COMPONENT OF THE MONEY STOCK LESS THE AMOUNT OF VAULT CASH HOLDINGS OF THRIPT INSTITUTIONS THAT IS INCLUDED IN THE CURRENCY COMPONENT OF THE MONEY STOCK PLUS, FOR INSTITUTIONS NOT HAVING REQUIRED RESERVE BALANCES, THE EXCESS OF CURRENT VAULT CASH OVER THE AMOUNT APPLIED TO SATISPY CURRENT RESERVE PRODIREMENTS. AFTER THE INTRODUCTION OF CRR. CURRENCY AND VAULT CASH PIGURES ARE MEASURED OVER THE MONDAY-ENDING COMPUTATION PERIOD. PRIOR TO CRR, ALL COMPONENTS OF THE MONETARY BASE OTHER THAN EXCESS RESERVES ARE SEASONALLY ADJUSTED AS A WHOLE, RATHER THAN BY COMPONENT, AND EXCESS RESERVES IS ADDED ON A NOT SEASONALLY ADJUSTED BASIS. AFTER CRR, THE SPASONALLY ADJUSTED SERIES CONSISTS OF SEASONALLY ADJUSTED TOTAL RESERVES (WHICH INCLUDES EXCESS RESERVES ON A MOT SEASONALLY ADJUSTED BASIS) PLUS THE SEASONALLY ADJUSTED CURRENCY COMPONENT OF THE MONEY STOCK PLUS THE REMAINING ITEMS SEASONALLY ADJUSTED AS A WHOLE.
