- 1/ RESERVES AND HOMETARY BASE PIGURES INCORPORATE ADJUSTMENTS FOR DISCONTINUITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MONETARY CONTROL ACT AND OTHER REGULATORY CHANGES TO RESERVE REQUIREMENTS. TO ADJUST FOR DISCONTINUITIES DUE TO CHANGES IN RESERVE BEQUIREMENTS ON RESERVABLE MONDEPOSIT LIABILITIES, THE SUM OF SUCH REQUIRED RESERVES ARE SUBTRACTED FROM THE ACTUAL SERIES. SINILARLY, IN ADJUSTING FOR DISCONTINUITIES IN THE MOMETARY BASE, REQUIRED CLEARING BALANCES AND ADJUSTMENTS TO COMPENSATE FOR PLOAT ALSO ARE SUBTRACTED PROM THE ACTUAL SERIES.
- 2/ TOTAL RESERVES NOT ADJUSTED FOR DISCONTINUITIES CONSISTS OF RESERVE BALANCES WITH FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS (WRICH EXCLUDE REQUIRED CLEARING BALANCES AND ADJUSTMENTS TO COMPENSATE FOR FLOAT) PLUS VAULT CASH USED TO SATISFY RESERVE REQUIREMENTS. - 3/ EXTENDED CREDIT CONSISTS OF BORROWING AT THE DISCOUNT WINDOW UNDER THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS ESTABLISHED FOR THE EXTENDED CREDIT PROGRAM TO HELP DEPOSITORY INSTITUTIONS DEAL WITH SUSTAINED LIQUIDITY PRESSURES. BECAUSE THERE IS NOT THE SAME WEED TO REPAY SUCH BORROWING PROSPTLY AS THESE IS WITH TRADITIONAL SHORT-TERM ADJUSTMENT CREDIT, THE MONEY MARKET IMPACT OF EXTENDED
- CREDIT IS SIMILAR TO THAT OF MONBORROWED RESERVES. 4/ RESERVE BALANCES WITH PEDERAL RESERVE BANKS PLUS VAULT CASH USED TO SATISFY RESERVE REQUIREMENTS LESS REQUIRED RESERVES.
- 5/ THE MONETARY BASE NOT ADJUSTED FOR DISCONTINUITIES CONSISTS OF TOTAL RESTRIES PLUS REQUIRED CLEARING BALANCES AND ADJUSTMENTS TO COMPENSATE FOR FLOAT AT PEDEBAL BESERVE BANKS PLUS THE CURRENCY COMPONENT OF THE HOMEY STOCK LESS THE AMOUNT OF VAULT CASH HOLDINGS OF THEIFT INSTITUTIONS THAT IS INCLUDED IN THE CURRENCY COMPONENT OF THE MONEY STOCK PLUS, FOR INSTITUTIONS NOT HAVING REQUIRED RESERVE FALANCES, THE EICESS OF CURRENT VAULT CASH OVER THE AMOUNT APPLIED TO SATISFY CURRENT RESERVE REQUIREMENTS. PRIOR TO CRR, ALL COMPONENTS OF THE MONETARY BASE OTHER THAN EXCESS RESERVES ARE SEASONALLY ADJUSTED AS A WHOLE, RATHER THAN BY COMPONENT, AND EXCESS RESERVES IS ADDED ON A NOT SEASONALLY ADJUSTED FASIS. AFTER CRB, THE SEASONALLY ADJUSTED SERIES CONSISTS OF SEASONALLY ADJUSTED TOTAL RESERVES (WHICH INCLUDES EXCESS RESERVES ON A ROT SEASONALLY ADJUSTED BASIS) PLUS THE SEASONALLY ADJUSTED CURRENCY COMPONENT OF THE MONEY STOCK PLUS THE REMAINING ITEMS SEASONALLY ADJUSTED AS A WHOLE.
