- 1/ RESERVES AND HOPETARY BASE PIGURES INCOMPORATE ADJUSTMENTS POR DISCONTINUITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE HONETARY CONTROL ACT AND OTHER REGULATORY CHANGES TO RESERVE REQUIREMENTS. TO ADJUST FOR DISCONTINUITIES DUE TO CHANGES IN RESERVE REQUIREMENTS ON RESERVABLE MONDEPOSIT LIABILITIES, THE SUB OF SUCH REQUIRED RESERVES ARE SUBTRACTED FROM THE ACTUAL SERIES. SIMILARLY, IN ADJUSTING FOR DISCONTINUITIES IN THE MOMETARY BASE, REQUIRED CLEARING BALANCES AND ADJUSTMENTS TO COMPENSATE FOR PLOAT ALSO ARE SUBTRACTED FROM THE ACTUAL SERIES.
- 2/ TOTAL RESERVES NOT ADJUSTED FOR DISCONTINUITIES CONSISTS OF RESERVE BALANCES WITH PEDERAL RESERVE BANKS (WHICH BICLUDE REQUIRED CLEARING BALANCES AND ADJUSTMENTS TO COMPENSATE FOR PLOAT) PLUS VAULT CASH USED TO SATISFI RESERVE REQUIREMENTS. - 3/ EXTENDED CREDIT CONSISTS OF BORROWING AT THE DISCOUNT WINDOW UNDER THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS ESTABLISHED FOR THE RITERDED CREDIT PROGRAM TO HELP DEPOSITORY INSTITUTIONS DEAL WITH SUSTAINED LIQUIDITY PRESSURES. BECAUSE THERE IS NOT THE SAME HEED TO REPAT SUCH BORROWING PROMPTLY AS THERE IS WITH TRADITIONAL SHORT-TERM ADJUSTMENT CREDIT, THE HOMET MARKET IMPACT OF RITEMBED CREDIT IS SIMILAR TO THAT OF NONBORROWED RESERVES.

PRIOR TO CRR, ALL COMPONENTS OF THE MOMETARY BASE OTHER THAN EXCESS RESERVES ARE SEASOWALLY ADJUSTED AS A WHOLE, RATHER THAN BY COMPONENT, AND RICESS BESERVES IS ADDED ON A NOT SEASONALLY ADJUSTED BASIS. AFTER CRR, THE SEASONALLY ADJUSTED SERIES CONSISTS OF SEASONALLY ADJUSTED TOTAL BESERVES (WHICH INCLUDES EXCESS RESERVES ON A NOT SEASONALLY ADJUSTED BASIS) PLUS THE SEASONALLY ADJUSTED CURRENCY COMPONENT OF THE MONEY STOCK PLUS THE REMAINING ITEMS SEASONALLY ADJUSTED AS A WHOLE.
