TO ADJUST FOR DISCONTINUITIES DUE TO CHARGES IN RESERVE REQUIREMENTS ON BESSEVABLE RONDEPOSIT LIABILITIES, THE SUN OF SUCH REQUIRED RESERVES ARE SUBTRACTED FROM THE ACTUAL SENIES. SINILABLY, IN ADJUSTING FOR DISCONTINUITIES IN THE HONSTARY RASE, REQUIRED CLEARING BALARCES AND ADJUSTMENTS TO COMPENSATE FOR FLOAT ALSO ARE SUBTRACTED FROM THE ACTUAL SERIES.

AFTER CHR, THE SEASONALLY ADJUSTED BASIS PLUS THE SEASONALLY ADJUSTED CURRENCY COMPONENT OF THE HONEY STOCK PLUS THE REMAINING ITEMS SEASONALLY ADJUSTED AS AN HOLE.
