TO ADJUST FOR DISCONTINUITIES DUE TO CHANGES IN RESERVE REQUIREMENTS ON RESERVABLE MONDEPOSIT LIABILITIES, THE SUN OF SUCH REQUIRED RESERVES ARE SUBTRACTED FROM THE ACTUAL SERIES. SINILARLY, IN ADJUSTING FOR DISCONTINUITIES IN THE MOMETARY BASE, REQUIRED CLEARING BALANCES AND ADJUSTMENTS TO COMPRUSATE FOR FLOAT ALSO ARE SUBTRACTED FROM THE ACTUAL SERIES.

BECAUSE THERE IS NOT THE SAME MEED TO REPAY SUCH BORROWING PROMPTLY AS THERE IS WITH TRADITIONAL SHORT-TERM ADJUSTMENT CREDIT, THE MOMEN MARKET IMPACT OF EXTENDED CREDIT IS SHILLAR TO THAT OF NOMBORROWED RESERVES.

 BY COMPONENT, AND EXCESS RESERVES IS ADDED ON A NOT SEASONALLY ADJUSTED BASIS. APTER CRR, THE SHASONALLY ADJUSTED BERIES
 CONSISTS OF SEASONALLY ADJUSTED TOTAL RESERVES (WHICH INCLUDES EXCESS RESERVES ON A NOT SEASONALLY ADJUSTED BASIS) PLUS THE
 SEASONALLY ADJUSTED CURRENCY COMPONENT OF THE HOWEY STOCK PLUS THE REHAINING ITEMS SEASONALLY ADJUSTED AS A WHOLE.
