TO ADJUST FOR DISCONTINUITIES DUE TO CHANGES IN RESERVE REQUIREMENTS OF RESERVABLE BONDEPOSIT LIABILITIES, THE SON OF SUCH REQUIRED RESERVES ARE SUBTRACTED FROM THE ACTUAL SERIES. SIGILARLY, IN ADJUSTING FOR DISCONTINUITIES IN THE MODETARY BASE, REQUIRED CLEARING BALANCES AND ADJUSTNESTS TO COMPRESATE FOR FLOAT ALSO ARE SUSTRACTED FROM THE ACTUAL SERIES.

THE SEASOBALLY ADJUSTED HOWETARY BASE CONSISTS OF SEASOHALLY ADJUSTED TOTAL RESERVE (WHICH INCLODES EICESS RESERVES ON A NOT SEASONALLY ADJUSTED BASIS) PLUS THE SEASONALLY ADJUSTED CURRENCY COMPONENT OF THE HOMEY STOCK PLUS THE BERAINING ITEMS SPASONALLY ADJUSTED AS A WHOLE.
