- 1/ RESERVES AND MONETARY BASE PIGURES INCORPORATE ADJUSTMENTS FOR DISCONTINUITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MONETARY CONTROL ACT AND OTHER REGULATORY CHANGES TO RESERVE REQUIREMENTS. TO ADJUST FOR DISCONTINUITIES DUE TO CHANGES IN RESERVE REQUIREMENTS ON RESERVABLE NONDEPOSIT LIABILITIES, THE SUM OF SUCH REQUIRED RESERVES ARE SUBTRACTED FROM THE ACTUAL SERIES. SIMILARLY, IN ADJUSTING FOR DISCONTINUITIES IN THE MONETARY BASE, REQUIRED CLEARING BALANCES AND ADJUSTMENTS TO COMPENSATE FOR PLOAT ALSO ARE SUBTRACTED FROM THE ACTUAL SERIES.
- 2/ TOTAL RESERVES NOT ADJUSTED FOR DISCONTINUITIES CONSISTS OF RESERVE BALANCES WITH FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS (WHICH EXCLUDE REQUIRED CLEARING BALANCES AND ADJUSTMENTS TO COMPENSATE FOR FLOAT) PLUS VAULT CASH USED TO SATISFY RESERVE REQUIREMENTS.
 SUCH VAULT CASH CONSISTS OF ALL VAULT CASH HELD DURING THE LAGGED COMPUTATION PERIOD BY INSTITUTIONS HAVING REQUIRED RESERVE BALANCES AT FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS PLUS THE AMOUNT OF VAULT CASH EQUAL TO REQUIRED RESERVES DURING THE MAINTENANCE PERIOD AT INSTITUTIONS HAVING NO REQUIRED RESERVE BALANCES.
- 3/ EXTENDED CREDIT CONSISTS OF BORROWING AT THE DISCOUNT WINDOW UNDER THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS ESTABLISHED FOR THE EXTENDED CREDIT PROGRAM TO HELP DEPOSITORY INSTITUTIONS DEAL WITH SUSTAINED LIQUIDITY PRESSURES. BECAUSE THERE IS NOT THE SAME NEED TO REPAY SUCH BORROWING PROMPTLY AS THERE IS WITH TRADITIONAL SHORT-TERM ADJUSTMENT CREDIT, THE MONEY MARKET IMPACT OF EXTENDED CREDIT IS SIMILAR TO THAT OF NONBORROWED RESERVES.
- 4/ HESERVE BALANCES WITH PEDERAL RESERVE BANKS PLUS VAULT CASH USED TO SATISFY RESERVE REQUIREMENTS LESS REQUIRED RESERVES.
- THE MONETARY BASE NOT ADJUSTED FOR DISCONTINUITIES CONSISTS OF TOTAL RESERVES PLUS REQUIRED CLEARING BALANCES AND ADJUSTMENTS TO COMPENSATE FOR FLOAT AT FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS PLUS THE CURRENCY COMPONENT OF THE MONEY STOCK PLUS, FOR INSTITUTIONS NOT HAVING BEQUIRED RESERVE BALANCES, THE EXCESS OF CURRENT VAULT CASH OVER THE ANOUNT APPLIED TO SATISFY CURRENT RESERVE REQUIREMENTS. AFTER THE INTRODUCTION OF CCR, CURRENCY AND VAULT CASH PIGURES ARE MEASURED OVER THE MONDAY-ENDING COMPUTATION PERIOD. THE SEASONALLY ADJUSTED MONETARY BASE CONSISTS OF SEASONALLY ADJUSTED TOTAL RESERVE (WHICH INCLUDES EXCESS RESERVES ON A NOT SEASONALLY ADJUSTED HASIS) PLUS THE SEASONALLY ADJUSTED CURRENCY COMPONENT OF THE MONEY STOCK PLUS THE MEMAINING ITEMS SEASONALLY ADJUSTED AS A WHOLE.
