## Factors Affecting Bank Reserves and Condition Statement of F.R. Banks

For immediate release February 27, 1964

The average of daily figures of total member bank reserves held during the week ended February 26 decreased \$139 million to \$20,034 million. Estimated currency and coin of member banks decreased \$19 million and their reserve balances at the Federal Reserve Banks decreased \$120 million. Estimated required reserves decreased \$38 million; and estimated excess reserves decreased \$101 million to \$323 million. Excess reserves exceeded member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks by \$123 million, compared with the revised figure of \$133 million the week before.

The principal changes reducing average reserve balances with Federal Reserve Banks were decreases of \$137 million in holdings of U. S. Government securities and \$91 million in member bank borrowings, and an increase of \$91 million in "other" F. R. accounts (net). The principal offsetting changes were decreases of \$161 million in currency in circulation and \$76 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. Total Reserve Bank credit decreased \$242 million.

As of Wednesday, February 26, holdings of U.S. Government securities bought outright were \$212 million higher than a week earlier and member bank borrowings were \$501 million higher.
