Factors Affecting Bank Reserves and Condition Statement of F.R. Banks

For immediate release May 28, 1964

The average of daily figures of total member bank reserves held during the week ended May 27 decreased a net of \$211 million to \$20,092 million. Estimated currency and coin of member banks increased \$44 million and their reserve balances at the Federal Reserve Banks decreased \$255 million. Estimated required reserves decreased \$119 million; and estimated excess reserves decreased \$92 million to \$315 million. Excess reserves exceeded member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks by \$107 million, compared with the revised figure of \$109 million the week before.

The principal changes reducing average reserve balances with Federal Reserve Banks were decreases of \$325 million in Federal Reserve float and \$90 million in member bank borrowings, and an increase of \$55 million in "other" F. R. accounts (net). The principal offsetting changes were an increase of \$104 million in U. S. Government securities bought outright, and decreases of \$83 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$31 million in currency in circulation. Total Reserve Bank credit decreased \$335 million.

As of Wednesday, May 27, holdings of U.S. Government securities bought outright were \$253 million higher than a week earlier, U.S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement were \$54 million lower, and member bank borrowings were \$326 million lower.
