CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS.

Aggregate reductions of \$63,500,000 in discounted bills and of \$1,100,000 in United States securities, as against an increase of \$7,200,000 in acceptances purchased in open market, accompanied by a corresponding decline of \$54,400,000 in deposit liabilities, are shown in the Federal Reserve Board's weekly bank statement issued as at close of business on July 26, 1922. Gold reserves show a further gain of \$9,200,000 and total cash reserves - a gain of \$12,200,000, while Federal reserve note circulation declined by \$6,000,000. The reserve ratio shows a rise for the week from 77.8 to 79.2 per cent.

Liquidation of member bank borrowings for the week was heaviest in the second district, the New York reserve bank reporting a reduction of \$63,000,000 in its holdings of discounted bills, besides a reduction of \$2,800,000 in its holdings of bills purchased in the open market. Cleveland reports a reduction of \$11,000,000 of discounted paper, as against an increase of \$6,400,000 in purchased bills, while substantial increases in discounted paper are shown for the Boston, Philadelphia and San Francisco banks.

Considerable shifting of gold through the gold settlement fund, besides accessions from without, accounts for the increase of \$37,900,000 in the gold reserves of the New York bank. Smaller increases in gold reserves aggregating over \$7,000,000 are shown for the Cleveland, Richmond and St. Louis banks. The largest decrease in gold reserves, viz., by \$13,900,000, is reported by the Philadelphia bank, San Francisco with a decrease of \$6,500,000 and Chicago with a decrease of \$5,200,000 being next in order.

Holdings of paper secured by Government obligations show a decline from \$176,300,000 to \$115,200,000. Of the total held \$93,200,000, or 80.9 per cent, were secured by Liberty and other U. S. bonds, \$5,400,000, or 4.7 per cent, by Victory notes, \$12,400,000, or 10.7 per cent, - by Treasury notes, and \$4,300,000, or 3.7 per cent, - by Treasury certificates, compared with \$118,100,000, \$7,000,000, \$40,700,000 and \$10,500,000 reported the week before.
