CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The consolidated statement of condition of the Federal reserve banks on November 4, made public by the Federal Reserve Board, shows an increase of \$65,900,000 in bills and securities and of \$18,700,000 in Federal reserve note circulation, and decreases of \$12,800,000 and \$6,000,000, respectively, in cash reserves and non-reserve cash. Holdings of discounted bills increased \$46,300,000 during the week, acceptances purchased in open market \$13,700,000, and Government securities \$5,500,000.

At the New York reserve bank discount holdings went up \$35,000,000, at San Francisco \$9,300,000, at Boston \$6,200,000, at Chicago \$4,800,000 and at Atlanta \$2,500,000. The Philadelphia bank reports a decline of \$9,700,000 in discount holdings, Cleveland of \$4,200,000, and Richmond \$1,900,000, while the four remaining banks report a total increase of \$4,400,000.

An increase of \$10,700,000 in open-market acceptance holdings is shown by the Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta, and increases of \$3,600,000 and \$2,900,000, respectively, by San Francisco and Boston. At the New York bank holdings of acceptances purchased in the open market declined \$4,000,000, and at Minneapolis - \$2,700,000, while the remaining banks show smaller changes in acceptance holdings for the week. A reduction of \$4,700,000 in the System's holdings of Treasury notes was more than offset by increases of \$8,600,000 in holdings of Treasury certificates and of \$1,600,000 in U. S. bonds.

Federal reserve note circulation increased at all of the reserve banks except Cleveland, which reports a decline of \$1,300,000. The principal increases during the week were: New York \$6,400,000, Boston \$3,500,000, San Francisco \$2,400,000, Richmond \$2,300,000, and Philadelphia \$2,000,000.
