CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The consolidated statement of condition of the Federal reserve banks on September 22, made public by the Federal Reserve Board, shows declines of \$78,800,000 in bill and security holdings and of \$85,300,000 in total deposits, partly offsetting the increases reported a week ago in connection with the Treasury's quarterly financial operations. Increases of \$96,100,000 in holdings of discounted bills and of \$7,900,000 in acceptances purchased in open market were more than offset by a reduction of \$182,900,000 in Government securities, holdings of which last week included \$192,000,000 of temporary certificates issued by the Treasury to the Federal reserve banks pending the collection of the quarterly installment of taxes. Federal reserve note circulation declined \$8,000,000 and cash reserves \$7,400,000.

The Federal Reserve Bank of New York reports an increase of \$42,500,000 in discount holdings, Chicago an increase of \$17,400,000, St. Louis \$16,300,000, San Francisco \$10,700,000, Cleveland \$6,400,000, Kansas City \$3,500,000 and Atlanta \$3,200,000. The remaining five banks show decreases aggregating \$3,800,000. Open-market acceptance holdings of the New York bank increased \$8,300,000 and of Atlanta \$3,400,000, while the St. Louis bank reports a decline of \$6,900,000. The System's holdings of U. S. securities declined \$182,900,000, or \$9,100,000 less than the amount of temporary certificates redeemed by the Treasury during the week.

The principal changes in Federal reserve note circulation during the week comprise declines of \$7,400,000 at the New York reserve bank, \$4,100,000 at Philadelphia, \$2,800,000 at San Francisco, and increases of \$3,000,000 at the Atlanta bank and \$2,500,000 at Dallas.
