## CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Largely as a result of the Treasury's financial operations, the consolidated statement of condition of the Federal reserve banks on November 16, made public by the Federal Reserve Board, shows a decrease for the week of \$93,200,000 in holdings of discounted bills and increases of \$131,100,000 in member bank reserve deposits and of \$174,600,000 in Government securities, holdings of which on November 16 included \$164,500,000 of temporary certificates issued by the Treasury to the Federal reserve banks. Total bill and security holdings increased \$78,800,000 and total deposits \$142,700,000, while cash reserves declined \$14,900,000 and Federal reserve note circulation \$28,300,000.

All of the Federal reserve banks report smaller holdings of discounted bills with the exception of Atlanta and Kansas City, which show increases of \$4,100,000 and \$3,300,000, respectively. The principal declines in discounts for the week were: New York \$51,300,000, Chicago \$14,000,000, Boston \$8,400,000, St. Louis and Cleveland \$5,400,000 each, Richmond and San Francisco \$4,600,000 each. The System's holdings of acceptances purchased in open market declined \$2,600,000, of Treasury notes \$42,300,000, and of United States bonds \$16,900,000, while holdings of Treasury certificates increased \$233,700,000, the amount held on November 16, as previously stated, including \$164,500,000 of temporary certificates issued by the Treasury to the Federal reserve banks.

The principal changes in Federal reserve note circulation for the week were declines of \$7,100,000 reported by the New York bank, \$5,200,000 by Philadelphia, \$4,000,000 by Chicago, \$3,900,000 by Cleveland, and \$3,200,000 each by Boston and Atlanta.
