## CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The consolidated statement of condition of the Federal reserve banks on January 30, made public by the Federal Reserve Board, shows an increase for the week of \$38,500,000 in holdings of discounted bills and decreases of \$18,600,000 in bills bought in open market and of \$300,000 in Government securities. Member bank reserve deposits increased \$32,100,000, Government deposits \$5,900,000, and cash reserves \$21,700,000, while Federal reserve note circulation declined \$15,500,000. Total bills and securities were \$19,600,000 above the amount held on January 23.

The principal changes in holdings of discounted bills for the week were increases of \$59,800,000 at the Federal Reserve Bank of New York and of \$8,700,000 at Boston, and decreases of \$15,000,000 at Chicago, of \$6,100,000 at St. Louis, of \$2,900,000 at Minneapolis, and of \$2,700,000 at Cleveland. The System's holdings of bills bought in open market declined \$18,600.000 and of U. S. bonds and Treasury certificates \$700,000 each, while holdings of Treasury notes increased \$1,200,000.

All of the Federal reserve banks except Philadelphia reported declines in Federal reserve note circulation for the week, the principal changes being decreases of \$5,400,000 at Chicago, \$2,700,000 at New York and \$2,100,000 at San Francisco and an increase of \$4,000,000 at Philadelphia.
