CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ending July 30, as reported by the Federal reserve banks, was \$934,000,000, a decrease of \$43,000,000 compared with the preceding week and of \$388,000,000 compared with the corresponding week of 1929.

On July 30 total reserve bank credit outstanding amounted to \$927,000,000, a decrease of \$19,000,000 for the week. This decrease corresponds with declines of \$17,000,000 in member bank reserve balances, \$10,000,000 in money in circulation and \$7,000,000 in unexpended capital funds, etc., offset in part by decreases of \$7,000,000 and \$8,000,000 in monetary gold stock and Treasury currency, respectively.

Holdings of discounted bills increased \$6,000,000 during the week, the principal changes being an increase of \$6,000,000 reported by the Federal Reserve Bank of New York and a decrease of \$4,000,000 at the Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis. The System's holdings of bills bought in open market declined \$20,000,000 and of Treasury certificates and bills \$23,000,000, while holdings of U. S. bonds increased \$7,000,000 and of Treasury notes \$16,000,000.
