CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ending November 19, as reported by the Federal reserve banks, was \$1,027,000,000, a decrease of \$6,000,000 compared with the preceding week and of \$608,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1929.

On November 19 total reserve bank credit amounted to \$1,003,000,000, a decrease of \$32,000,000 for the week. This decrease corresponds with decreases of \$41,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and \$3,000,000 in unexpended capital funds, etc., and an increase of \$7,000,000 in monetary gold stock, offset in part by a decrease of \$15,000,000 in Treasury currency and an increase of \$5,000,000 in money in circulation.

Holdings of discounted bills increased \$13,000,000 during the week, the principal changes being increases of \$5,000,000 at the Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta, \$4,000,000 at Richmond and \$3,000,000 each at Boston and Cleveland. The System's holdings of bills bought in open market declined \$29,000,000 and of Treasury notes \$25,000,000, while holdings of Treasury certificates and bills increased \$19,000,000 and of U. S. bonds \$1,000,000.
