CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ending December 10, as reported by the Federal reserve banks, was \$1,109,000,000, an increase of \$16,000,000 compared with the preceding week and a decrease of \$459,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1929.

On December 10 total reserve bank credit amounted to \$1,134,000,000, an increase of \$26,000,000 for the week. This increase corresponds with increases of \$41,000,000 in money in circulation and \$24,000,000 in member bank reserve balances, offset in part by increases of \$32,000,000 in Treasury currency and \$4,000,000 in monetary gold stock and a decline of \$2,000,000 in unexpended capital funds, etc.

Holdings of discounted bills increased \$6,000,000 during the week, the principal changes being increases of \$14,000,000 at the Federal Reserve Bank of New York and \$3,000,000 at Richmond, and decreases of \$8,000,000 at San Francisco and \$2,000,000 at Cleveland. The System's holdings of bills bought in open market increased \$25,000,000, of U. S. bonds \$16,000,000 and of Treasury certificates and bills \$7,000,000, while holdings of Treasury notes declined \$8,000,000.
