## CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ending March 4, as reported by the Federal reserve banks, was \$921,000,000, an increase of \$8,000,000 compared with the preceding week and a decrease of \$242,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1930.

On March 4 total reserve bank credit amounted to \$908,000,000, an increase of \$4,000,000 for the week. This increase corresponds with an increase of \$6,000,000 in money in circulation and a decrease of \$22,000,000 in Treasury currency, offset in part by an increase of \$9,000,000 in monetary gold stock and decreases of \$13,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and \$2,000,000 in unexpended capital funds, etc.

Holdings of discounted bills declined \$2,000,000 each at the Federal Reserve Banks of Cleveland and Atlanta and increased \$6,000,000 at the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco, all Federal reserve banks combined showing a small increase for the week. The System's holdings of bills bought in open market decreased \$5,000,000 and of Treasury notes \$15,000,000, while holdings of Treasury certificates and bills increased \$14,000,000.
