CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ending July 22, as reported by the Federal reserve banks, was \$953,000,000 which was the same as in the preceding week and a decrease of \$24,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1930.

On July 22 total reserve bank credit amounted to \$942,000,000, a decrease of \$9,000,000 for the week. This decrease corresponds with decreases of \$16,000,000 in money in circulation, \$4,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and \$2,000,000 in unexpended capital funds, etc., offset in part by decreases of \$5,000,000 in monetary gold stock and \$5,000,000 in Treasury currency.

Holdings of discounted bills increased \$16,000,000 at the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco, \$2,000,000 at Atlanta and \$20,000,000 at all Federal reserve banks. The System's holdings of bills bought in open market declined \$3,000,000 and of Treasury notes \$4,000,000 while holdings of U. S. bonds increased \$4,000,000.
