CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ending July 13, as reported by the Federal reserve banks, was \$2,417,000,000, an increase of \$40,000,000 compared with the preceding week and of \$1,465,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1931.

On July 13 total reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,417,000,000, an increase of \$9,000,000 for the week. This increase corresponds with increases of \$52,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and \$2,000,000 in unexpended capital funds, nonmember deposits, etc., and a decrease of \$26,000,000 in Treasury currency, adjusted, offset in part by a decrease of \$61,000,000 in money in circulation and an increase of \$10,000,000 in monetary gold stock.

Holdings of bills discounted increased \$9,000,000 at the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco, \$4,000,000 at Atlanta, \$3,000,000 at Dallas and \$16,000,000 at all Federal reserve banks. The System's holdings of bills bought in open market declined \$15,000,000, of United States bonds \$15,000,000 and of United States Treasury notes \$9,000,000, while holdings of Treasury certificates and bills increased \$44,000,000.
