COMDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ending November 16, as reported by the Federal reserve banks, was \$2,205,000,000, a decrease of \$18,000,000 compared with the preceding week and an increase of \$169,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1931.

On November 16, total reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,208,000,000, an increase of \$9,000,000 for the week. This increase corresponds with an increase of \$53,000,000 in member bank reserve balances, offset in part by increases of \$14,000,000 in monetary gold stock and \$11,000,000 in Treasury currency, adjusted, and by decreases of \$22,000,000 in money in circulation and \$2,000,000 in unexpended capital funds, nonmember deposits, etc.

Holdings of discounted bills declined \$4,000,000 at the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco and the same amount at all Federal reserve banks. The System's holdings of United States Treasury notes increased \$5,000,000, while holdings of Treasury certificates and bills declined by the same amount.
