CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal reserve bank credit cutstanding during the week ending January 4, as reported by the Federal reserve banks, was \$2,152,000,00, a decrease of \$37,000,000 compared with the preceding week and an increase of \$219,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1932.

On January 4, total reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,163,000,000, a decrease of \$5,000,000 for the week. This decrease corresponds with an increase of \$19,000,000 in monetary gold stock and a decrease of \$18,000,000 in member in circulation, offset in part by an increase of \$32,000,000 in member bank reserve balances.

Holdings of discounted bills increased \$4,000,000 at the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco, and declined \$9,000,000 at Atlanta, \$4,000,000 at Cleveland, \$3,000,000 at Philadelphia and \$16,000,000 at all Federal reserve banks. The System's holdings of bills bought in open market and of United States Government securities show little change for the week.
