## CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ending January 25, as reported by the Federal reserve banks, was \$2,080,000,000, a decrease of \$24,000,000 compared with the preceding week and an increase of \$267,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1932.

On January 25 total reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,067,000,000, practically unchanged from a week ago. A decrease of \$32,000,000 in member bank reserve balances was offset by increases of \$9,000,000 in money in circulation and \$14,000,000 in unexpended capital funds, nonmember deposits, etc., and a decrease of \$10,000 in monetary gold stock.

Holdings of discounted bills increased \$12,000,000 at San Francisco and \$16,000,000 at all Federal reserve banks. The System's holdings of bills bought in open market and of United States Government bonds show practically no change for the week, while holdings of Treasury notes increased \$9,000,000 and those of Treasury certificates and bills decreased \$24,000,000.
