CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ending February 15, as reported by the Federal reserve banks, was \$2,099,000,000, an increase of \$30,000,000 compared with the preceding week and of \$304,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1932.

On February 15 total reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,136,000,000, an increase of \$51,000,000 for the week. This increase corresponds with increases of \$149,000,000 in money in circulation and \$17,000,000 in unexpended capital funds, nonmember deposits, etc., and decreases of \$24,000,000 in monetary gold stock and \$45,000,000 in Treasury currency, adjusted, offset in part by a decrease of \$183,000,000 in member bank reserve balances.

Holdings of discounted bills increased \$16,000,000 at the Federal Reserve Bank of Cleveland, \$6,000,000 at San Francisco, \$4,000,000 at New York and \$33,000,000 at all Federal reserve banks. The System's holdings of bills bought in open market and of United States bonds show no change for the week, while holdings of United States Treasury notes increased \$39,000,000 and those of Treasury certificates and bills decreased \$14,000,000.
