## CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ending March 1, as reported by the Federal reserve banks, was \$2,585,000,000, an increase of \$317,000,000 compared with the preceding week and of \$57,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1932.

On March 1 total reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,936,000,000, an increase of \$585,000,000 for the week. This increase is largely accounted for by an increase of \$732,000,000 in money in circulation and a decrease of \$116,000,000 in monetary gold stock, offset in part by a decrease of \$233,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and an increase of \$37,000,000 in Treasury currency, adjusted.

Holdings of discounted bills increased \$217,000,000 at the Federal Reserve Bank of New York, \$71,000,000 at Philadelphia, \$34,000,000 at Cleveland and \$385,000,000 at all Federal reserve banks. The System's holdings of bills bought in open market increased \$204,000,000, while holdings of United States Treasury notes increased \$5,000,000 and those of Treasury certificates and bills declined \$3,000,000.
