#### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ending April 5, as reported by the Federal reserve banks, was \$2,587,000,000, a decrease of \$200,000,000 compared with the preceding week and an increase of \$987,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1932.

On April 6 total reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,574,000,000, a decrease of \$114,000,000 for the week. This decrease corresponds with decreases of \$92,000,000 in money in circulation and \$11,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and an increase of \$11,000,000 in monetary gold stock, offset in part by a decrease of \$3,000,000 in Treasury currency, adjusted.

Bills discounted decreased \$55,000,000 at the Federal Reserve Bank of New York \$39,000,000 at Philadelphia and \$109,000,000 at all Federal reserve banks. The System's holdings of bills bought in open market declined \$24,000,000, while holdings of United States Government securities shows little change for the week.
