### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ending April 12, as reported by the Federal reserve banks, was \$2,555,000,000, a decrease of \$32,000,000 compared with the preceding week and an increase of \$926,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1932.

On April 12 total reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,528,000,000, a decrease of \$46,000,000 for the week. This decrease corresponds with a decrease of \$114,000,000 in money in circulation, and increases of \$10,000,000 in monetary gold stock and \$57,000,000 in Treasury currency, adjusted, offset in part by increases of \$120,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and \$14,000,000 in unexpended capital funds, nonmember deposits, etc.

Bills discounted increased \$6,000,000 at the Federal Reserve Bank of New York, and declined \$7,000,000 each at Philadelphia and San Francisco and \$8,000,000 at all Federal reserve banks. The System's holdings of bills bought in open market declined \$39,000,000, while holdings of United States Government securities show little change for the week.
