CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ending April 26, as reported by the Federal reserve banks, was \$2,457,000,000, a decrease of \$53,000,000 compared with the preceding week and an increase of \$698,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1932.

On April 26 total reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,412,000,000, a decrease of \$78,000,000 for the week. This decrease corresponds with decreases of \$74,000,000 in money in circulation and \$23,000,000 in member bank reserve balances offset in part by decreases of \$3,000,000 in monetary gold stock and \$7,000,000 in Treasury currency, adjusted, and an increase of \$9,000,000 in unexpended capital funds, nonmember deposits, etc.

Bills discounted declined \$22,000,000 at the Federal Reserve Bank of New York, \$8,000,000 at San Francisco, \$5,000,000 at Kansas City and \$29,000,000 at all Federal reserve banks. The System's holdings of bills bought in open market declined \$31,000,000, while holdings of United States Treasury notes increased \$48,000,000 and those of Treasury certificates and bills declined by a like amount.
