### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ending July 5, as reported by the Federal reserve banks, was \$2,225,000,000, an increase of \$29,000,000 compared with the preceding week and a decrease of \$152,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1932.

On July 5 total reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,206,000,000, an increase of \$24,000,000 for the week. This increase corresponds with an increase of \$77,000,000 in money in circulation and a decrease of \$24,000,000 in Treasury currency, adjusted, offset in part by decreases of \$67,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and \$9,000,000 in unexpended capital funds, nonmember deposits, etc.

Bills discounted increased \$10,000,000 at the Federal reserve Bank of San Francisco, and decreased \$9,000,000 at Cleveland, \$3,000,000 each at New York and Philadelphia and \$9,000,000 at all Federal reserve banks. The System's holdings of bills bought in open market increased \$15,000,000 and of Treasury certificates and bills \$28,000,000, while holdings of United States Treasury notes declined \$8,000,000.
